Harry Targ, Ph.D. will address the Deerfield Progressive Forum on “U.S. Foreign Policy” on January 17, 2009.

A political science professor at Perdue University, Dr. Targ’s teaching and research interests include the US and international political economy, neo-liberal globalization, US foreign policy, the politics of capital and labor, and Cuba, the Caribbean and Latin America. He serves on the steering committee of the graduate program in American Studies and is the coordinator of the Committee on Peace Studies.

Professor Targ is a coeditor of “Dialogue and Initiative,” a theoretical journal of the Committees of Correspondence. He co edited “Marxism Today: Essays on Capitalism, Socialism, and Strategies for Social Change,” (1996). Other publications include “Challenging Late Capitalism, Neo-Liberal Globalization, and Militarism: Building a Progressive Majority (2006) and “Cuba and the United States: A New World Order?” (1992).

He received his Ph.D. from Northwestern University and both of his undergraduate degrees from the University of Illinois.
