

## Challenges in Latin America

Dynamic and informative, Dr. Ronald W. Cox will return to the Deerfield Progressive Forum on December 12, 2008 to discuss, "Challenges in Latin America."

An Associate Political Science Professor at Florida International University since 1991, he has lectured extensively at the Universities of Missouri and Wisconsin where he received his undergraduate degrees and Ph.D. respectively. He has also presented his written papers at professional conferences.

His written publications include books, manuscripts, professional journal articles, and chapters in books as well as editing "Business and the State in International Relations" (1996). Topics include U.S. corporate power and the global economy, U.S. policy in Central America, the business conflict approach to international politics, explaining business support for regional trade agreements such as NAFTA and CBI, 'sectoral' conflict and U.S. intervention in Central America, American foreign policy, private interests, and the Central American Common Market, private interests and U.S. Foreign policy in the post cold war period, and Clinton's economic initiatives.
